

HOTELS and MOTELS near the CNY FIBER ARTS FESTIVAL

We can't specifically endorse any of the following, but we offer this list to save our visitors and vendors a little time in seeking accommodations. There is also camping available at the site. *That* we can recommend!

Closest options

Ye Olde Landmark Tavern – right in Bouckville on Route 20 - just a couple of minutes away. Also an upscale restaurant. Expensive. [\(315\) 893-1810](tel:3158931810)

Madison Bed, Book, and Candle – a small B & B in Madison, the first town east of Bouckville on Route 20. Just 5 or 10 minutes away. [\(315\) 893-7077](tel:3158937077)

Hotel Solsville – also in the village of Madison, although not right on Route 20. Ten minutes away. Also a restaurant. [\(315\) 893-7698](tel:3158937698)

Madison Motor Court – right on Route 20, just a few minutes away. Has no website, but it appears to be active. Also appears to be a very basic sort of motel. [315-893-1818](tel:3158931818).

In Hamilton, a college town about 15 minutes away

RESTAURANTS near the CNY FIBER ARTS FESTIVAL

Ye Olde Landmark Tavern, the Hotel Solsville, and the Colgate Inn, as mentioned above.

Quack's Diner – Very close, in Madison on Route 20. Classic diner food.

Ray Brother's Barbecue – on Route 20 west of Bouckville.

Suzi's Place in Bouckville is only open for breakfast and lunch.

There are other spots in Hamilton and Cazenovia, and about 15 minutes east of the festival on Route 20 is an upscale place called Michael's.
